Re: Water Reuse Study

Dear Council President Peters,

The San Diego County Taxpayers Association has reviewed the Water Reuse Study and we recommend that the City conduct an updated independent fiscal analysis of the water reuse study's NC-3 Strategy [North City Mix w/ San Vicente indirect potable reuse (IPR)]. We also recommend quantifying and evaluating other local and regional brackish and seawater desalination opportunities as a means to diversify the region's water supply.

The independent fiscal analysis should identify the availability of incentives, rebates and grants from water agencies and the state that would help to offset the costs of IPR and desalination. Furthermore, the analysis should be followed by serious efforts to provide educational outreach on IPR.

Recognizing that there is no single solution to fix the region's water needs, we support the City's efforts to concurrently pursue alternative strategies to ensure reliability of water supply.
