

## November 2008 Ballot Recommendations

### STATE PROPOSITIONS

**Proposition 1A: NO**

Safe, Reliable High-Speed Train Bond Act.

**Proposition 3: NO POSITION\***

Children's Hospital Bond Act. Grant Program. Initiative Statute.

**Proposition 7: NO**

Renewable Energy Generation. Initiative Statute.

### LOCAL PROPOSITIONS

**Proposition A: YES**

County of San Diego. Establishes a regional fire protection parcel tax for improved and enhanced fire resources and services.

**Proposition B: NO**

San Diego Unified Port District. Amends the master plan by the adoption of "The Port of San Diego Bayfront Redevelopment Initiative".

**Proposition C: NO**

City of San Diego Charter Amendment. Designating the use of lease revenue from Mission Bay Park.

**Proposition J: NO**

City of El Cajon ½ cent sales tax to provide funding for general fund city services.

**Proposition K: NO**

City of Encinitas. Requires guests of short-term vacation rental units to pay a 2% TOT for beach sand replenishment and stabilization projects.

*\*A supermajority 60% vote of the San Diego County Taxpayers Association (SDCTA) Board of Directors is required for a position to be taken on any ballot measure.*

**Proposition L: NO**

City of La Mesa ¾ cent sales tax to provide funding for general fund city services.

**Proposition M: YES**

City of National City. Would repeal an existing one percent sales tax used for city services.

**Proposition O: NO**

City of San Marcos. Would require voter approval of general plan amendments modifying or changing land use categories or designations.

**Proposition Q: NO**

City of Chula Vista Charter Amendment. Makes the City Attorney and elected City Officer.

**Proposition R: YES**

Southwestern Community College District \$389 million bond measure.

**Proposition S: YES**

San Diego Unified School District \$2.1 billion bond measure.

**Proposition T: YES**

Escondido Union High School District \$98 million bond measure.

**Proposition U: YES**

Grossmont Union High School District \$417 million bond measure.

**Proposition V: YES**

Lakeside Union Elementary School District \$79.55 million bond measure.

**Proposition X: YES**

South Bay Union School District \$59.4 million bond measure.
